Purser Report:

Secretary Report:

The Board approved (a) the February 2025 Purser's Report and (b) the February 2025 Board minutes with no additional changes.

Kenrick and Shaun agreed to work on setting up a Paypal account for the WOC. Kenrick will further report back on the issue of investing reserve funds in certificates of deposit or bonds under IRS 501c3 rules.

The Board considered various viewpoints on a proposed gate and preferred the lower gate option. Tom will meet with the PUG and mention that the Club may be willing to share some cost on the upper gate, but our main concern is the lower gate. If there is an upper gate, the Club prefers to just have a universal access code (instead of unique codes). Kenrick will find out about removing a red exit push button on the lower gate.

For the derby, no meal tickets will be given. Instead, John will prepare extra food – for 200. Jeff will designate a head volunteer coordinator for the derby.

Josh made a presentation about future plans for social media, our logo and community outreach. Tom indicated that Josh and Kenrick should investigate utilizing our club resources to accomplish this, such as finding a graphic design artist in the club.
